## Understanding the Purpose

The home and the school are two of the most significant influences in the lives of our young people. It is important that families of students enrolled in Tri-State Christian School understand and agree with the purpose and standards of the school.

The **MISSION of Tri-State Christian School** is to educate students from a Biblical worldview for excellence in lifelong learning and Christian character. Additionally, we want to see students develop strong relationships with God, parents and peers. Students should begin to model Christ's example of serving others and should be striving for biblical excellence as stated in the Standard of Conduct.

## Tri-State Christian School's Statement of Faith

We believe in one God, Creator and Lord of the universe eternally existing in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We believe that the Bible, both the Old and the New Testaments, is God's authoritative, inspired word. It is without error in all its teaching, including creation, history, its own origins and salvation. It is of supreme and final authority in all matters of faith and life.

We believe that Jesus Christ, God's Son, was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, died a substitutionary atoning death on the cross, rose bodily from the dead and ascended to heaven, where as truly God and truly man, He is the only mediator between God and man.

We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins, according to the Scriptures, as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice; and that all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood. That all people are lost sinners and cannot see the Kingdom of God, except through the new birth which takes place through repentance of sin and faith toward God. Justification is by grace through faith in Christ alone.

We believe in the necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit for the individual's new birth and growth to maturity and for the church's constant renewal in truth, wisdom, faith, holiness, love, power, and wisdom. Every believer is called to live and walk in the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit so that he will bear fruit to the glory of God and not fulfill the lusts of the flesh.

We believe in "that blessed hope", the personal and imminent return of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. That Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church which is made up of all believers everywhere in the world and locally the Church is a group of believers who are organized to do God's will. Its calling is to worship God and witness concerning its Head, Jesus Christ, proclaiming the Gospel among all nations and demonstrating its commitment by compassionate service to the needs of human beings and by promoting righteousness and justice.

We believe that Jesus Christ will personally and visibly return in glory to raise the dead and bring salvation and judgment to completion. God will fully manifest His kingdom when He establishes a new heaven and new earth, in which He will be glorified and exclude all evil, suffering and death.
