Qualifications and Experience

The ideal candidate will have earned a B.S/B.A. Degree in Music Education with successful student teaching experience and a definite call to teach in a Christian School. In addition, the candidate must be a mature born-again Christian believer, capable of modeling exemplary Christian character and leadership befitting a teacher of a Christian school.

1. Exemplary people skills.
2. Administrative and organizational abilities.
3. Basic computer proficiency.
4. Effective communication skills.
5. The ability to lift at least 25 pounds.
6. The ability to sign the TSCS Statement of Faith and Professional Code of Conduct
7. The ability to provide a written testimony of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior.
8. The ability to pass a mandatory background check.

The main duties and responsibilities of the position include but not limited to:

1. Teach effectively, a full range of students, in Music Theory and Choir from K-12th grade.
2. Plan, prepare, market, and lead student musical performances.
3. Develop ensembles for grades 9-12th.
4. Instruct and coach student-led (9-12th) contemporary worship team for chapels.
