1. A \$100 non-refundable application fee per student (family maximum of \$200) is due with the application.
2. Should a student enroll at any point after the first week of school, tuition charges will be determined by prorating for the weeks attending.
3. A multi-child discount is available for full-time students. (2<sup>nd</sup> oldest student - 10% off, 3<sup>rd</sup> student – 20% off, 4<sup>th</sup> student – 30% off.)
4. Financial aid availability will be determined by an outside agency (FACTS) used by many Christian schools. This agency does not give financial aid money, they only determine a recommended amount. TSCS then award financial aid money to families from its own operating budget and raised throughout the school year. Your aid will be figured using 1040 tax forms, special family hardship situations, and calculated allowances for multi-child families. This financial aid process, which is confidential, must be completed before any financial aid will be awarded.
